We'd like to start by sharing with you some great news regarding Nottinghamshire's visitor economy. The latest Scarborough Tourism Economic Activity Monitor (STEAM) report 2017 revealed a healthy growth for Nottinghamshire in 2017.

The number of visitors to the city and county increased by 1.3% to **35.89 million in 2017**, up from 35.42 million in 2016. The value of tourism to the local Nottinghamshire economy also saw growth of 3.6% to **£1.814 billion compared to £1.751 billion the previous year**. Various factors contributed to this great result, including several conferences and events brought to the city by - and with support from - our team. Some of the biggest ones are ORBS International Scientific Meeting and 30<sup>th</sup> European Congress of Arachnology to name just a few. [Read more in the official press release.](#)

The programme will consist of plenary and invited talks, as well as contributed presentations and posters. There will also be a 2-day industrial exhibition and Industry Technology Programme.

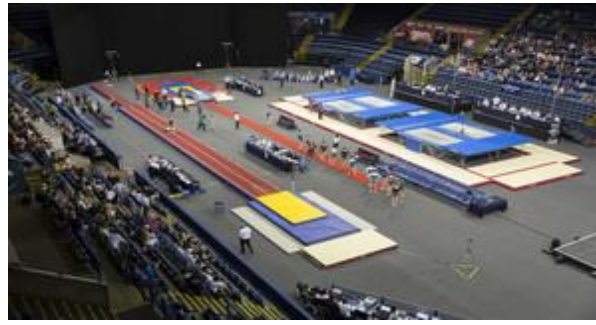
Over 350 delegates will come together to attend lectures from world-renowned experts in the field, and get up to date with cutting-edge research.
