CTIVITIES: HISTORIC HOUSES

Nottinghamshire is packed with amazing historical homes and grand country estates just waiting to be explored. Why not book your guests in for a visit?

Wollaton Hall and Deer Park

A spectacular 16th century Elizabethan Mansion and now a Grade I listed building housing the city's Natural History Museum and Nottingham Industrial Museum, Wollaton Hall is set in 500 acres of spectacular gardens and parkland. It was also used as the setting for Wayne Manor in the 2012 film The Dark Knight Rises.

Entry to the house and gardens is free and guided tours cost £10pp

Holme Pierrepont Hall
